The following vetting services are being requested for this greyhound during 1 scheduled appointment unless advised otherwise. Additional treatment or diagnostics need to be approved by a representative of Greyhound Pets of America-MN.

1. General Physical Exam – foster person to discuss any concerns with Vet.
2. Pre-anesthesia Blood Work
3. Dental with x-rays and extractions as necessary (no additional approval required)
4. Neuter/Spay – medication as deemed necessary (pain meds, antibiotics, etc)
5. SNAP 4DX test
6. Fecal Check – only if it has not already been completed (please check with foster)
7. Nail clipping
8. Vaccinations Needed (if due within 3 months)
